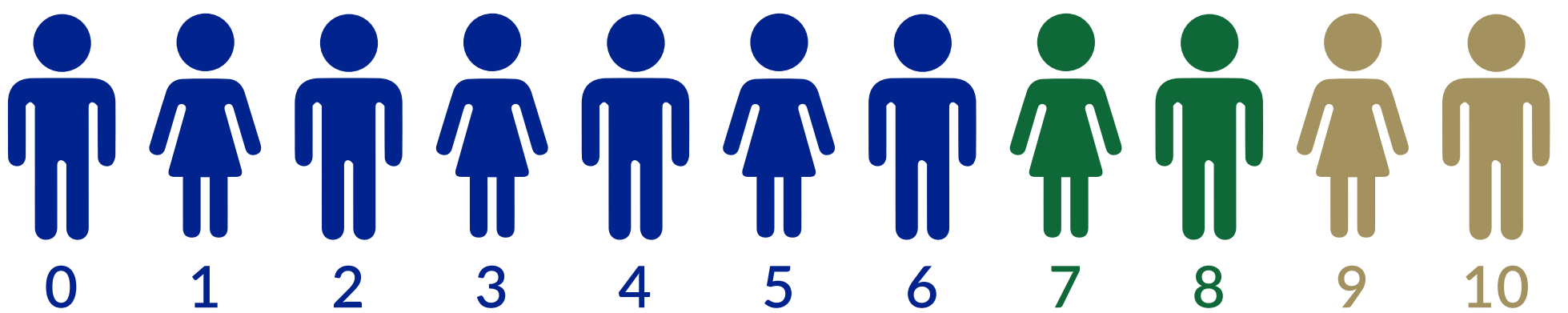

Net Promoter Score is an alternative to traditional customer satisfaction research and gauges customer loyalty

HOW NPS IS CALCULATED

CUSTOMERS WHO PARTICIPATE in an NPS survey are classified as one of the following after submitting their responses to the question, "How likely are you to recommend our school to a friend or colleague?"



DETRACTORS	PASSIVES	PROMOTERS
<p><u>THOSE WHO SELECT 0-6</u> Unhappy customers, high likelihood for negative word of mouth, high churn rate.</p>	<p><u>THOSE WHO SELECT 7-8</u> Currently satisfied but easily tempted by your competition.</p>	<p><u>THOSE WHO SELECT 9-10</u> Typically loyal enthusiastic customers likely to recommend you.</p>

WHAT THE SCORE MEANS



$$\text{NPS} = \% \text{ PROMOTERS} - \% \text{ DETRACTORS}$$

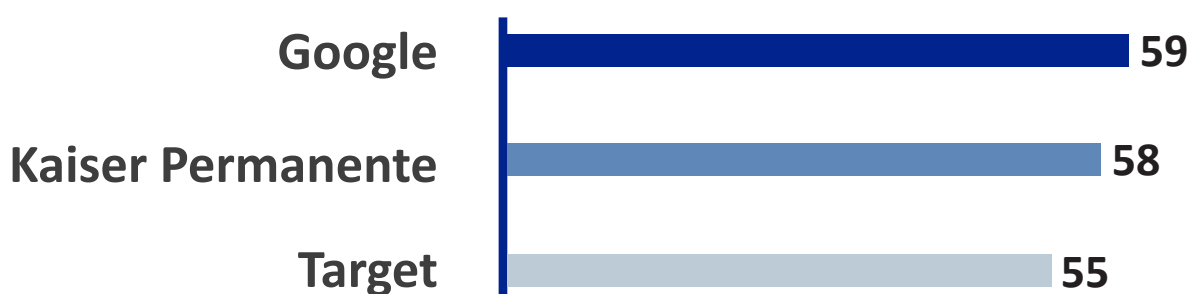
- 0 Any negative NPS scores (scores less than zero) indicate that improvement is needed
- 0-30 A score of 0-30 is considered good
- 30+ Scores above 30 are considered great
- 30-50 Most industry benchmark scores are between 30 and 50
- 50+ NPS scores above 50 are difficult to achieve and are typically associated with the most respected companies in the world
